## **Return of Module 4 Learning Materials and Resources**

Dear Students,

### **Next Steps**

Students who were registered in Module 4 are asked to bring borrowed learning materials and resources to the main entrance of the Thomas Merton Centre (located at 171 Speers Road, in Oakville) on one of the following dates:

- Tuesday, April 14, 2020 through Friday, April 17, 2020 from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

### **Learning Materials and Resources – Return Protocol**

Before returning borrowed learning materials and resources, **students are asked to read carefully and follow the return protocol below:**

- Attach a piece of paper with your full name, your Module 4 course, and your teacher's name inside the front cover of textbooks or novels. If students are in possession of other borrowed items, please attach the above information to the items by using masking tape (or post it notes). **In addition, please indicate on the piece of paper above if you wish to have your**

**refundable textbook deposit cheque returned or destroyed by Thomas Merton administration.**

- Students are asked to place Module 4 resources in a tied plastic bag before bringing them to the main entrance of the Thomas Merton Centre during the scheduled dates and times listed above.
- The doors at the main entrance of the Thomas Merton Centre will be wide open. Beyond these doors, students will find containers labelled with their Module 4 teacher's name and Module 4 course name.
- Students are asked to place their borrowed items in the box that corresponds with their teacher's name and course, and to leave the school premises immediately. **Students will not be permitted to enter the school.**

**NOTE: Please observe all mandatory physical distancing measures while returning materials and resources next week.**
