Extended Return of Module 4 Learning Materials and Resources

Next Steps

- **Monday May 11, 2020 through Friday, May 15, 2020 from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.**

Learning Materials and Resources – Return Protocol

Before returning borrowed learning materials and resources, **students are asked to read carefully and follow the return protocol below:**

- Attach a piece of paper with your full name, your Module 4 course, and your teacher's name inside the front cover of textbooks or novels. If students are in possession of other borrowed items, please attach the above information to the items by using masking tape (or post it notes). **In addition, please indicate on the piece of paper above if you wish to have your**

refundable textbook deposit cheque returned or destroyed by Thomas Merton administration.

- Students are asked to place Module 4 resources in a tied plastic bag before bringing them to the main entrance of the Thomas Merton Centre during the scheduled dates and times listed above.
- The doors at the main entrance of the Thomas Merton Centre will be wide open. Beyond these doors, students will find a **Large Yellow Plastic Bin to the right**.
- Students are asked to place their borrowed items in the Large Yellow Plastic Bin, and to leave the school premises immediately. **Students will not be permitted to enter the school.**

NOTE: Please observe all mandatory physical distancing measures while returning materials and resources this week.
