KEY ASSESSMENT TASKS

PRE-EMPLOYMENT CLASSROOM COMPONENT

Prepare for employment, begin development of PPLP (Learning Plan for Placement), Resume, Cover Letter, Application Form, Safety Quiz, Ethics, Self Esteem, Workplace Issues, Safety Presentation, Employee Rights/Responsibilities Report, Project and Presentation.

INTEGRATION COMPONENT

Log/Journal with evidence of Learning, Exit Resume, Cover Letter, Reflective Learning Assignments, Research Project – Trends and Opportunities.



Skills such as work habits, teamwork, organization, initiative and working independently will contribute to the student's overall evaluation.
